Concepts of God – designs that reflect concepts about God and His Kingdom.

Attributes of God – designs that represent attributes of God Himself.

Declarations of God – designs that embody declarations that God makes over us or that we make on His behalf.

The Fruit of the Spirit – designs that symbolise the fruit of the Spirit.

The Nations – designs that represent nations, regions, kingdoms or redemptive attributes of nations.

Leadership – designs that reflect attributes found in godly leaders.

The who, what, when, where, why and how of banners in the hands of Christians

On this banner, the LORD stands on a huge pile of gold with hands outstretched toward the heavens. The colour of heavenly wisdom provides a backdrop.

The image here is of a leader, in fact any person with responsibility for stewarding resources and wealth, crying out to his God and Judge for extra grace to be absolutely accountable for the resources under their care. The plenary asterisks or stars represent God playfully and generously responding with many nuggets of grace and wisdom. While God is our Judge, He is also very free with insight and revelation about how to manage or steward the resources He has placed in our care.

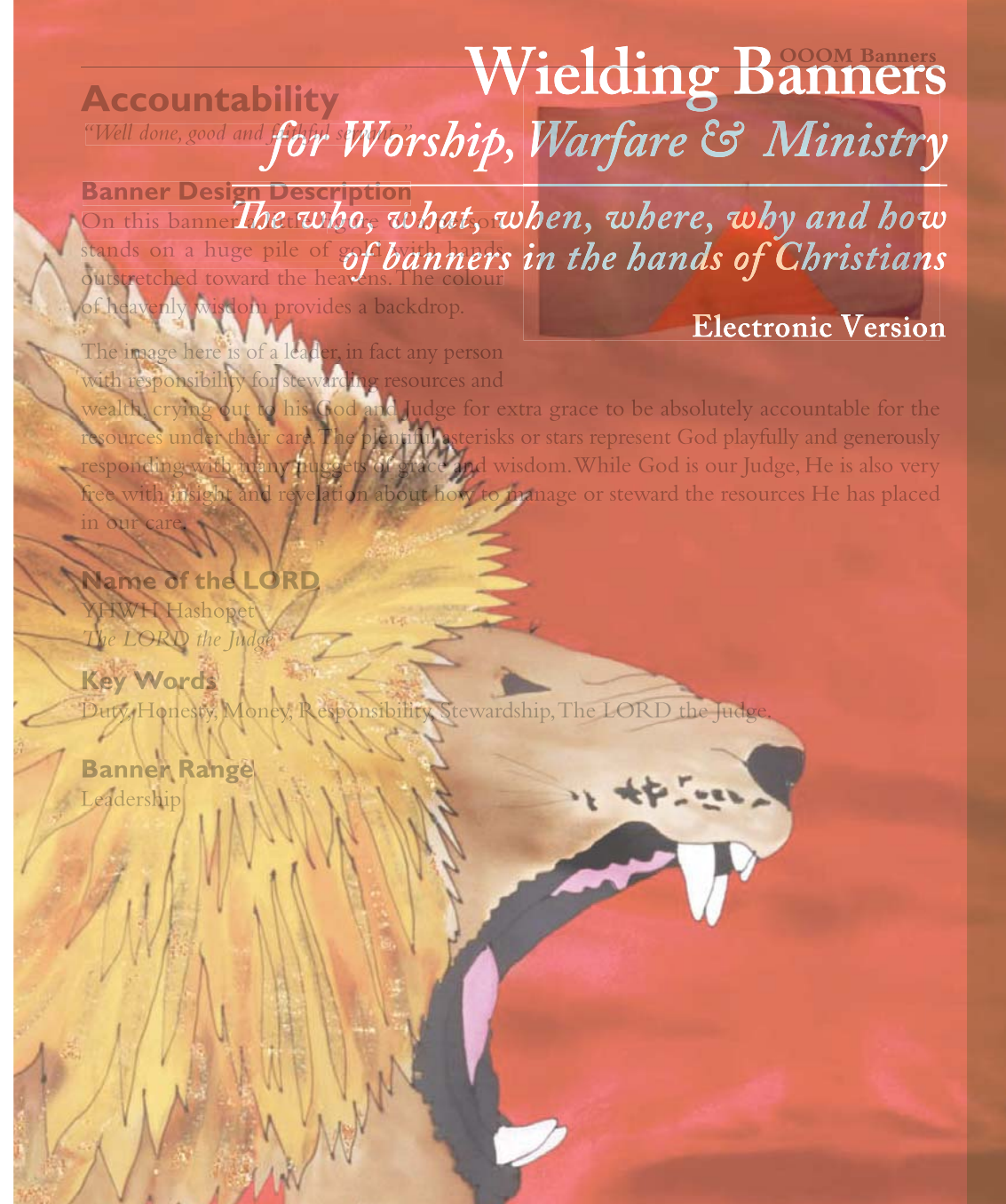
